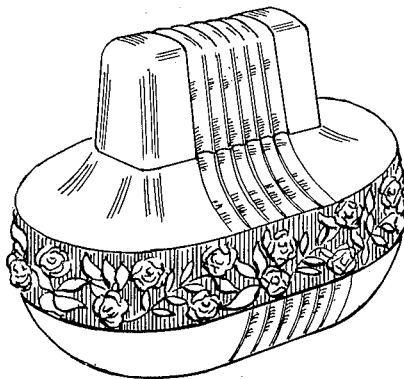
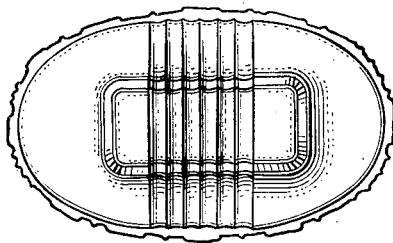

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, George Bruce Kamp, a citizen of the United States, residing at Philadelphia, in the county of Philadelphia and State of Pennsylvania, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Table Lighter, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

Fig. 1 is a perspective view of a table lighter, showing my new design; the opposite side of which is the same as shown in Fig. 1; and Fig. 2 is a top plan view of the lighter shown in Fig. 1.
