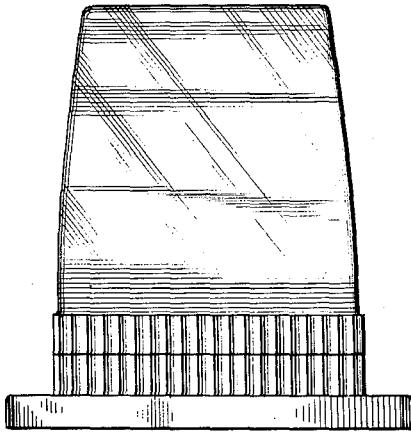

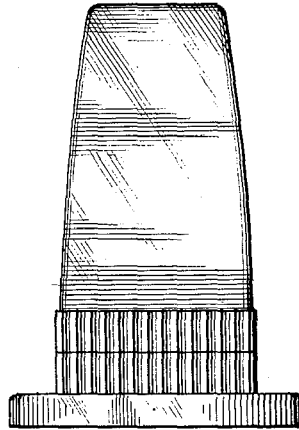

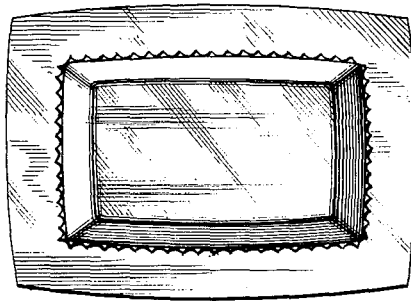

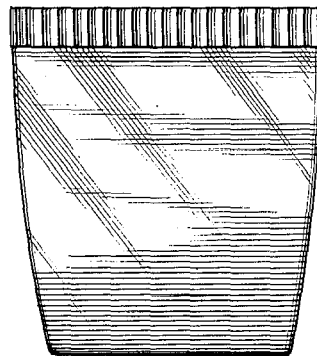

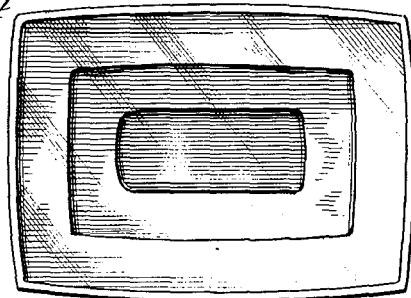
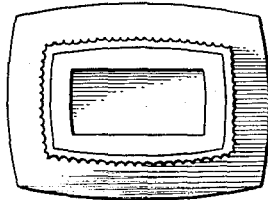

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, William J. Condon, a citizen of the United States, residing at Chicago, in the county of Cook and State of Illinois, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Combined Stand and Cover for a Cigarette Lighter or the like, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof:

In the drawing:

Figure 1 is a side elevational view of a combined stand and cover for a cigarette lighter or the like, showing my new design;

Figure 2 is an end elevational view;

Figure 3 is a top plan view;

Figure 4 is a bottom plan view;

Figure 5 is a side elevational view of the cover as it appears when used to hold cigarettes;

Figure 6 is a side elevational view of the stand proper; and

Figure 7 is a reduced scale top plan view of the stand without the cover.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a combined stand and cover for a cigarette lighter or the like, substantially as shown.
