## DESCRIPTION


FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a combined cigarette lighter and sculptured charm showing our new design:


FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof;


FIG. 3 is a front, right perspective view thereof;

FIG. 5 is an enlarged top plan view thereof; the bottom of the combined cigarette lighter and sculptured charm being plain and unadorned.










